Amplifier is also a leader in the national giving circle movement, working with partner networks and organizations across the American philanthropic sector to elevate collective giving Nationwide.

Today, we are poised to grow, with a newly emerging strategy to expand our impact with individuals, partners, giving circles, and the broader philanthropic field.

Who You Are

We're looking for a leader with a deep entrepreneurial spirit to join us in the role of Program Director. The Program Director will assume responsibility for designing and executing Amplifier's programs and consulting engagements as Amplifier expands its reach.

We're seeking a team player who is proactive, strategic, creative, and resourceful. This is a role for someone who likes to bring ideas to fruition and to test new approaches. We are looking for someone with the ability to both plan and execute - who is equally comfortable designing programs, creating partnerships, and facilitating groups.

The Program Director will report directly to Amplifier's CEO. We prefer a Program Director based out of Amplifier's national office in Brooklyn, NY, but will consider highly qualified candidates located in other parts of the country.

Responsibilities:

- Lead the development, design, and execution of Amplifier's evolving suite of programs.
- Build and oversee a network of facilitators to support Amplifier's work.
- Source and develop new partnerships and consulting engagements with organizations across the Jewish and philanthropic sectors.
- Ensure programmatic data collection.
- Work closely with, coach, and advise giving circle leaders as well as giving circle host organizations.
- Serve as a thought leader on philanthropy, giving circles, and Amplifier's work, writing and presenting at events and conferences.
- Oversee consultants, trainers, and other contract professionals.

Education & Experience:

- 6-10 years of experience in program management, philanthropy, community building/organizing, or other relevant field. Experience with innovative approaches to philanthropy and/or fundraising preferred - including giving circles, teen foundations, or women's funds.
- Demonstrated ability to implement program evaluation, and make data-driven decisions.
- Business development experience – bringing on new clients or partnerships – is a plus.
- Knowledge of philanthropy and the nonprofit sector and knowledge of the Jewish communal sector. Fluency in one or both is preferred.

Key Attributes:

- Creative problem-solver who is unafraid of change, excited to experiment with new solutions, and ready to pivot when needed.
- Strong planning, organizational and time management skills, the ability to prioritize and manage multiple large projects at once.
- Desire to work collaboratively as a member of a small team.
- Excellent group facilitation, public speaking and presentation skills.
- Excellent oral, written and interpersonal communication skills.
- Willingness and ability to travel.

Salary range is \$90,000 - \$110,000 a year and includes a competitive benefits package. Amplifier is a fun, fast-paced organization. Title is negotiable and will depend on level of experience. We value and invest in professional development and growth. We are open, flexible and committed to results.
